What causes blown fuses & tripped Breakers?

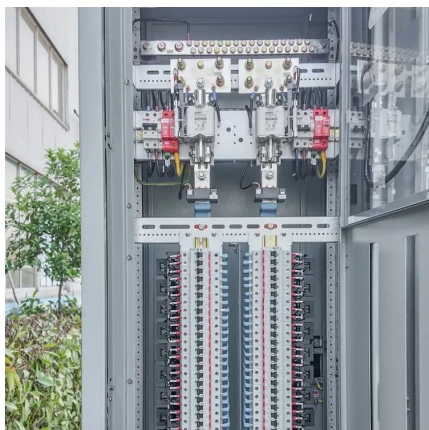

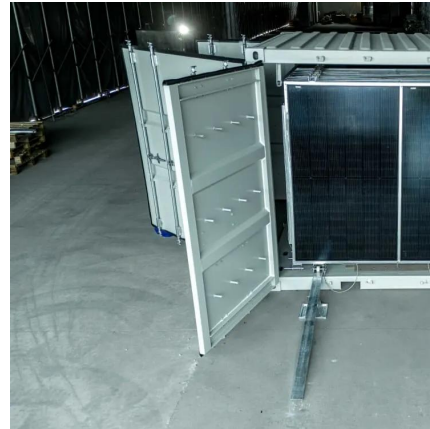

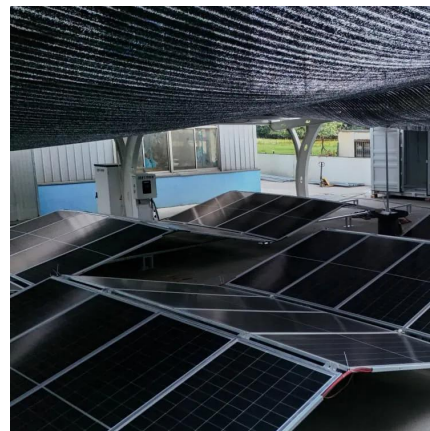
